MENTORING TO OUR MIDDLE SCHOOL LEADERSHIP STUDENTS





WORK WITH FACILITATORS

As a high school "Leadership Advisor," you will work with the facilitators, checking in before and after each weekly session. Have weekly dialogs to continually adjust how you are assisting and strive for continuous improvement.



BUILD RELATIONSHIPS WITH STUDENTS

Develop a relationship with the students you are working with. Get to know all of their names, likes and dislikes. Focus on 4 to 5 students and build a strong relationship with them.



SESSION PARTICIPATION

Participate in session activities by responding to questions, offering opinions, affirming the students' participation in exercises led by the facilitator.



CLASSROOM MANAGEMENT

Assist facilitator with classroom management as asked. Ensure any safety issues or behavior issues are communicated to the facilitator and program administrators

ABOUT LUKE'S LEADERS

Luke's Leaders is inviting high school students to work side-by-side with the Luke's Leaders adult volunteers working in the Program. We believe you can provide excellent mentorship to our middle school leadership students. You will be working as a Leadership Advisor for these programs: 8th grade - YMCA Youth in Government, 7th Grade - YMCA Leaders Club, and 6th Grade - Peace Learning Center.

Luke's Leaders is a Leadership Development Program that meets once a week after school. Students learn about aspects of leadership and practice leadership skills by participating in discussions and exercises.

Luke's Leaders partners with the YMCA of Central Indiana and the Peace Learning Center, who provide professional curriculum and certified facilitators to deliver the program.
