MONDAY

John 3:3 “**Very truly, I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God without being born from above.**”

MONDAY REFLECTION

What does God want to say to me through these words?

What new thing is God doing right now?

John 5:17: ***"Jesus answered them, 'My Father is still working, and I also am working."***

Where do I see Jesus at work?

What does this say for me? For our church?

SATURDAY

2 Corinthians 4:18 ***"So we fix our eyes not on what is seen, but on what is unseen."***

SATURDAY REFLECTION

God, what do you want to say to me through these words?

What does it mean to fix my eyes on what is unseen?

SUNDAY
