WEEK 2

MONDAY

Proverbs 3:5-6 ***“Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not rely on your own insight. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths.”***

MONDAY REFLECTION

Given the announcement this weekend of Pastor Rob’s plans for retirement, what does this verse mean for you? For our church?

TUESDAY

Matthew 16:18: ***“And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not prevail against it.”***
(for fuller context you may wish to read Mt 16:13-20)

TUESDAY REFLECTION

What does this verse say to you about the mission of the church?

WEDNESDAY

John 14:12 ***“Very truly, I tell you, the one who believes in me will also do the works that I do and, in fact, will do greater works than these, because I am going to the Father.”***

WEDNESDAY REFLECTION

Based on what you know of the life and ministry of Jesus, make a list of the kinds of works Jesus did?

Now, what does that list say about the mission of the church?

THURSDAY

Matthew 28:19 **“Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you.”**

THURSDAY REFLECTION

What does this say for the church today?

This is called “The Great Commission.” Don’t be limited by the actions themselves or the coercive sense of the verse. Think of what the actions symbolize. And given what you believe about the spirit and nature of Jesus, what would He want us to understand about this commission?)

FRIDAY

John 13:14-15 **“So if I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another’s feet. For I have set you an example, that you also should do as I have done to you.”**

FRIDAY REFLECTION

What does this verse mean for you personally?

What does it mean for the church?

SATURDAY

John 15:5 **“(Jesus said), I am the vine; you are the branches. Those who abide in me and I in them bear much fruit, because apart from me you can do nothing.”**

SATURADAY REFLECTION

What does this say our key task is?

What does the image of a vine and branches say about how we live out that task?

SUNDAY
